Accepting new patients


We are accepting new patients so if you know someone who needs a GP then ask at reception for the forms. Signing up is easy.

This chart shows the % clinical targets we achieved. It covers numerous conditions including lung disease, heart disease, diabetes, cancer and stroke care.






Organisational Performance

This chart shows the % of people who reported their overall experience of the surgery to be very or fairly good.






Confidence & Trust
